

A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING MS. DOREEN JAEN-MOONEY FOR THE CONFERMENT OF THE HONORARY TITLE OF MEMBER OF THE BRITISH EMPIRE (MBE) IN THE UNITED KINGDOM
