EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Laoag By-Pass Road is a national infrastructure project intended to decongest traffic and facilitate efficient travel of goods and persons to further stimulate tourism and economic development in the north. This project was realized under the term of Representative Rodolfo C. Fariñas of the First District of Ilocos Norte as part of the Congressman's numerous achievements.

On November 15, 2015, the son and namesake of the Representative, Rodolfo G. Fariñas Jr. met a fatal vehicular accident along the Laoag By-Pass Road. He died at the age of twenty (20) years old, leaving behind a legacy as a young public servant. Rodolfo G. Fariñas, Jr. served as president of the Sangguniang Kabataan for the province, pushing for local reforms and stimulating participative governance and initiative in the youth of Ilocos Norte.

This bill is a tribute to the life and accomplishments of Rodolfo G. Fariñas Jr., as a son, as a youth leader, and as a dedicated public servant – that even in his death, he will be remembered as a man of service through the Laoag By-Pass Road.

In view of the foregoing, passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
NAMING THE LAOAG BY-PASS ROAD AS THE RODOLFO G. FARIÑAS
JR. HIGHWAY

SECTION 1. The Laoag By-Pass Road located in Laoag City is hereby named as Rodolfo G. Fariñas Jr. Highway.

SECTION 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall include in their annual budget the funds necessary for the implementation of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen days following the completion of its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
