EXPLANATORY NOTE

For several years the twelve (12) kilometer road from Barangay Cumadcad to Barangay Macalaya, Municipality of Castilla, Province of Sorsogon has been neglected. With only the use of Countrywide Development Funds and Congressional Initiative Allocations, a significant portion of the road has been paved.

Barangay Macalaya is noted for its abundant fishery products and other agricultural crops produced by other neighboring barangays. A fishery port in Barangay Macalaya has been constructed to serve its fisherfolks. To hasten the improvement of said road network, there is a need to convert it into a National Road. In so doing, it will benefit not only the residents of Barangay Cumadcad and Barangay Macalaya but also other barangays along the way and the neighboring Municipality of Magallanes, Province of Sorsogon and the Municipalities in the Island of Ticao, Province of Masbate.

Hence, the immediate approval of this Bill is earnestly requested.

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE CUMADCAD – MACALAYA PROVINCIAL ROAD IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF CASTILLA, PROVINCE OF SORSOGON INTO A NATIONAL
ROAD

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Cumadcad – Macalaya Provincial Road in the Municipality of Castilla, Province of Sorsogon is hereby converted into a national road.

SEC. 2. The Secretary of the Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
