EXPLANATORY NOTE


This bill seeks to convert Lapu-Lapu Avenue located in the City of Navotas into a national road.

The City of Navotas' progress as a port city, has led the way for said City to become a dynamic force in trade and transportation, and consequently, experience a higher level of social and economic activities within its territory.

The furtherance of this growth requires good serviceable roads and basic infrastructure for the timely transport of goods and services, and more importantly, ensures the safety of the Navoteños from perils along the road as they perform their daily activities.

Making our roads better through the conversion of a major thoroughfare into a national road will reduce road accidents in Navotas and ensure public safety. It is for this reason that this humble representation asks this Honorable House to enact a law authorizing the conversion of Lapu-Lapu Avenue into a national road.

In this context, approval of the attached bill is earnestly sought.

HOUSE BILL NO. 946

INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE TOBIAS "TOBY" M. TIANGCO

AN ACT
CONVERTING LAPU-LAPU AVENUE, NAVOTAS CITY,
METRO MANILA INTO A NATIONAL ROAD
AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Lapu-Lapu Avenue, Navotas City, Metro Manila is hereby converted and declared into a national road.

SECTION 2. The amounts necessary to cover the improvement, repairs and maintenance of said road as envisioned in the implementation of this Act shall be charged to the funds of the Department of Public Works and Highways not thereby appropriated under the present General Appropriations Act. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary for the improvement, repair and maintenance of this national road shall be included in the annual budget of the Department of Public Works and Highways.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
