**Explanatory Note**

Currently, the Quarter's allowance of the Philippine National Police (PNP) is as follows:

This bill seeks to increase the quarter's allowance of the PNP. It is a small token that we could give them considering the task that they are given. The author hopes that the said increase would motivate our police further in fulfilling their mandates.

This measure was filed by the Magdalo Party-List in the 16th Congress and was subsequently referred to the Committee on Public Order and Safety.

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**AN ACT**  
**INCREASING THE QUARTERS ALLOWANCE OF COMMISSIONED OFFICERS**  
**AND NON-COMMISSIONED OFFICERS OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE**  
**AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote professionalism in  
2 the Philippine National Police (PNP) and to provide adequate remuneration and benefits to its  
3 members. Pursuant thereto, the government shall provide adequate support and incentives to the  
4 members of the PNP.

6           **SEC. 2.** The commissioned and non-commissioned officers of the PNP shall be provided  
7 with housing facilities consistent with the requirements of the service. Allowances per capita  
8 shall be provided for all commissioned and non-commissioned officers to attain this objective.  
9 Such allowances may be commuted if no housing facilities can be made available.

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11           **SEC. 3.** In order to upgrade the morale of the PNP, the quarters allowance for married  
12 commissioned and non-commissioned personnel shall be adjusted in accordance with the  
13 following rate:

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3           **SEC. 4.** The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act is hereby authorized  
4 to be appropriated in the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of the year following its enactment  
5 into law and thereafter.

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7           **SEC. 5.** The Secretary of the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) and  
8 the Police Director General of the Philippine National Police (PNP) shall promulgate rules and  
9 regulations for the effective implementation of this Act.

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11           **SEC. 6.** All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with this  
12 Act, are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

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14           **SEC. 7.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its complete publication in  
15 the Official Gazette or in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
