AN ACT

DECLARING OCTOBER 28 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF DAVAO OCCIDENTAL IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. October 28 of every year is hereby declared a special non-working holiday in the Province of Davao Occidental in commemoration of its founding anniversary.

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

On October 28, 2013 which coincided with the Barangay Elections, Republic Act No. 10360 was ratified and the new Province of Davao Occidental was created. Said date has also been accepted as the founding of the new province.

In view of the foregoing, the undersigned is seeking the approval from this august body in designating October 28 of each year as a non-working holiday being the founding anniversary of Davao Occidental.
