**RESOLUTION TO REVIVE THE PAMPANGA RIVER CONTROL SYSTEM AND TO
INCLUDE IT IN THE YEARLY BUDGET OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC
WORKS AND HIGHWAYS**

WHEREAS, flooding from the Pampanga River is an annual disaster in Central Luzon causing widespread economic damage to Central Luzon and Metro Manila from crop devastation, damage to vital infrastructures, and loss of human lives;

WHEREAS, strategic planning, construction and maintenance of flood control structures such as dikes, revetments, levees, and desilting of rivers, and their tributaries are vital to the prevention of annual floods in Central Luzon especially in Pampanga;

WHEREAS, strategic planning, construction and maintenance of flood control structures was the concern and duty of the Pampanga River Control System until it was bypassed;

WHEREAS, other river control systems are successful in mitigating flood damage and are vigorously supported by the Department of Public Works and Highways;

WHEREAS, there has been limited flood control projects to address the real situation of the Pampanga River:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED.

- 1. To revive the Pampanga River Control System to be the lead office under the Department of Public Works and Highways to address all aspects of major flood control along the Pampanga River; and**
- 2. To urgently include the Pampanga River Control System in the annual budget of the Department of Public Works and Highways.**
