PROVIDING FOR THE CONVERSION OF DAN
KARITON ROAD, DALANDANAN, IN THE CITY OF
VALENZUELA, METRO MANILA INTO A NATIONAL
ROAD AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the city road of the Dan Kariton Road, Dalandanan, in the City of Valenzuela, Metro Manila into a national road.

In its current state, existing roadway is heavily traversed by motorists from local residents and those from nearby municipalities. In our collective desire to provide for the safety and convenience of our constituents who ply this route, it is submitted that as to the maintenance of this road, the national government is better equipped to handle. Conversion of this road into a national road would also allow its development to be in line with the national infrastructure plan which as it stands is highly crucial in resolving the traffic crisis that is plaguing Metro Manila.

It is in this light that the early approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT
PROVIDING FOR THE CONVERSION OF DAN
KARITON ROAD, DALANDANAN, IN THE CITY OF
VALENZUELA, METRO MANILA INTO A NATIONAL
ROAD AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of
Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. The Dan Kariton Road, Dalandanan, in the
City of Valenzuela, Metro Manila is hereby converted into a
National Road.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of Public Works and
Highways shall include in the Department's program the
improvement, repair and maintenance of said road, the
funding of which shall be included in the annual General
Appropriation Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days
after its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of
general circulation.
