EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Bill seeks to designate December 28 of every year as the "Tudela Day" and a special non-working holiday in the municipality.

The municipality of Tudela, 2nd District of the Province of Misamis Occidental in Region X Northern Mindanao, a 4th class municipality comprising of 33 barangays. It was created by virtue of Executive Order No. 61, series of 1920.

Thus, in recognition of the men and women who pioneered the creation of the Municipality of Tudela, Misamis Occidental, this bill proposes to set December 28 as a non-working holiday. This day would be an opportunity for the residents to celebrate the milestones achieved by the municipality and reflect on their duties and responsibilities as people of Tudela.

In view of the foregoing, approval of this bill is earnestly sought.

AN ACT DECLARING DECEMBER 28 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TUDELA, 2ND DISTRICT, PROVINCE OF MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL TO BE KNOWN AS "TUDELA DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. December 28 of every year is hereby declared a special non-working holiday in the Municipality of Tudela, Province of Misamis Occidental 2nd District in commemoration of its Founding Anniversary to be known as "Tudela Day".

SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days from its publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) newspapers of general publication.
