Government Enterprises and Privatization (Technical Working Group)	HBs 2439 & 3487	Rep. Villarín and Deputy Speaker Escudero	Amending certain provisions of RA 10149 otherwise known as the Government-Owned and Controlled Corporation (GOCC) Governance Act of 2011 (by excluding from the coverage of the law the compensation of employees of non-chartered GOCCs, among others)	<p>The technical working group (TWG), chaired by Rep. Rodel Batocabe (Party-List, AKO BICOL), will deliberate further on the three bills in its next meeting.</p> <p>With regard to HB 3014, Rep. Batocabe underscored the need to discuss fully with the labor sector and different stakeholders the proposal to abolish the GCG.</p>

Batocabe	Abolishing the Governance Commission for GOCC (GCG), repealing for the purpose RA 10149	<p>GCG Chair Samuel Dagpin Jr. said that dialogues with the stakeholders have been conducted on the matter, but no official report on the result of the dialogues has been released yet. Dagpin suggested to the TWG to invite a representative from the Office of the President (OP) to its next meeting to answer some of its queries, pointing out that the GCG is under the OP's supervision.</p> <p>The TWG also discussed the criteria adopted by the GOCCs for granting performance-based bonuses to their officers and employees.</p> <p>The GCG was asked to submit a report on its meetings and dialogues with different stakeholders regarding the proposed abolition of the GCG.</p>

Garcia (J.E.) and Villafuerte	Establishing and institutionalizing the Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) for local government units, and allocating for this purpose the Seal of Good Local Governance Fund	The technical working group (TWG), chaired by Rep. Jose Enrique "Joet" Garcia III (2 nd District, Bataan), terminated its deliberation on the Substitute Bill to HBs 6338 and 8221. The substitute bill, after its finalization, will be reported out to the mother Committee for its consideration and approval.
