#### QUESTION OF PRIVILEGE OF REP. ALONTE

REP. ALONTE. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

Mr. Speaker, distinguished colleagues, Ladies and Gentlemen of this august Chamber. I stand before you

today not for myself but rather for the people that I serve, the very institution to which I belong and for my family, most especially for my children.

How do you even respond to your seven-year-old daughter's question, "Mama, are you okay?"

As a mother of two, I am in deep pain knowing that my young children are hurting because of these baseless accusations thrown at me. Whether this is the first or the hundredth time, I could not get used to seeing my kids worry about me or our family. Every mother would agree with me.

My kids are the reasons I am working to create a better future for this country. We as parents work hard to ensure that they stand a chance for a better life, a better country. I do not subscribe to illegal acts and I will never participate in efforts to undermine the truth because I am one with this administration in aiming for a Philippines to be free of drugs, corruption and criminality. This is my dream for my own children and for every young Filipino.

I cannot deny that the past few days have been difficult not only for me but more so for my family. I was surprised to hear that my name, something I protected very well my whole life, was dragged into baseless and false accusations.

I could take the easier route and just sweep this thing under the rug knowing fully in my conscience that I am innocent. After all, why dignify an accusation that did not come with a solid evidence and concrete proof? But this is not just my battle. When I said "yes" to public service 19 years ago, I know that my name will always be associated with the people I am serving and the city or district I am representing. Hence, I needed to speak up. I needed to clear my name.

Politics is a calling. You have to want and have the willingness to serve, to sacrifice, and to believe that there is a higher order, almost a divine calling to make a difference and be the stimulus of positive change. Politics is also a not-so-clean-cut world but it is up to you to just accept it as it is or do something good about it.

With 333,278 Biñanenses I am representing in the Lone District of Biñan and the 292 Members of the House of Representatives which I am part of, I could not just easily allow my name to be tarnished, because dragging my name into malicious insinuations is tantamount to dragging my beloved city and the people I serve with all my heart, as well as the name and integrity of this august Chamber. That I could not simply ignore.

My track record speaks for itself. I am a firm believer that integrity is a cornerstone of good governance. It has always been my resolute will that under my leadership, honest and sincere service to every Biñanense should be practiced at all levels of the government. I have a no-nonsense stance on corruption and injustice.

I have been in public service for almost all my life and I have served my constituents from being

a Councilor, Vice Mayor, Mayor, and now their Representative in Congress. I have lived my political life with few goals and purpose: serve with dignity and honesty and I serve my constituents well. I preach about this and I practice what I preach. "The truth will always set you free"—a strong and powerful quote that resonates in my life every waking hour. As a public servant, my life and achievements are an open book. I welcome my constituents to question my leadership and my judgment because this is their right and duty. Our constituents should question our motives, ask if it benefits the people as these are their fundamental rights as a citizen. The government is in the same way. It is their right to question and to ask if they find any discrepancy or if they have questions about service and about what is good for the people.

This is simply called "good governance."

The current government is an example of making sure that they ask, they inquire and, if needed, they persecute under the law those who are found guilty of regressing the country and its people. The status does not matter, the political affiliation does not matter, and what a few or what the majority thinks also does not matter. The reason the Lady Justice is blindfolded is because it does not want to see anything but the facts. This government attempts to do just that.

It may not be perfect or the government may not be perfect in everyone's eyes, but it is trying and we, as citizens, need to support and encourage unity and peace. We can question and we can inquire, but at the end of the day, we the citizens of the Republic of the Philippines should and must believe that the good will always triumph over evil, that justice is served to those who believe in and practice truth and honesty.

What I learned through all these is that in spite of the shock and the pain that it has caused my family, my children and myself, there is a purpose and meaning to all this, there is a message that is being given to me and that is to continue to serve without fear of rejection, ridicule or insult; and that if you serve truthfully and

honestly, if you serve by putting your constituents first and your personal interests last, then this world, this country has hope for a better future.

I believe that the generation after ours will read the history books and see that one time in the history of the Philippine Congress, there was a woman who, in spite of her unexpected and painful experience, in spite of the hurt and negative publicity it has given her and her entire family, in spite of feeling betrayed and being judged through public opinion, in spite of the deep sorrow and anguish it has caused, remained resilient and continued to believe in the government she serves and the party affiliation she belongs to, and made her constituents know that justice and truth will always prevail, and that the Lady Justice, all knowing and blindfolded, has exonerated her and instead of lashing out, instead of bitterness and hate, has promoted love, unity and cooperation.

As I end my message, I would like to thank my colleagues in this Seventeenth Congress, who sent their kind words of encouragement and support. Kilala po ninyo kung sino kayo. Together with Congressman Daza, we are also questioning the Journal of last Wednesday's session because what I raised was in support of Congressman Daza's position that Rule No. 54 talks about the motion to close the debate and that motion by itself, according to the Rules, is debatable—allowing three members of the Majority to speak in favor and two members of the Minority to speak up and air their views. Whether it is negative or positive, they should have been allowed and we were insisting on that point. We never agreed that the voting should continue because the debate has not even started and Rule 54 is very clear. If you read it and you reread it over and over again, it talks about a motion to close the debate and it does not talk about a *viva voce* vote right away but rather asks the Body: "Are you in favor of closing the debate or not?" Then, three members of the Majority should be allowed to defend the motion where two members of the Minority can oppose. That rule was not followed and the *viva voce* vote which was done is not in accordance with the rules. We were shouting at the top of our voices on that matter. I am sorry to note that was not included in this Journal and I am requesting the Majority Leader to make the necessary corrections so that we are not misunderstood. We are talking about very important matters like following the rules of the House and, therefore, we are requesting that the Journal be adjusted accordingly and exactly as I had said, when I was raising

it, and these should be registered in the Journal for purposes of clarity and truthfulness in the reflections of our Journal.
