
Mr. Speaker:

**AN ACT**  
**PENALIZING INFLUENCE PEDDLING**

*Introduced by* : Representatives EVELINA G. ESCUDERO, MARIA VIDA ESPINOSA BRAVO, JOSEPH STEPHEN S. PADUANO, GWENDOLYN F. GARCIA, RAMON V.A. ROCAMORA AND MARLYN L. PRIMICIAS-AGABAS

*Committee Referral* : Revision of Laws

**OBJECTIVES:**

- To prevent corruption at its inception
- To deter the commission of influence peddling

**KEY PROVISIONS:**

- Defines influence peddling as the act of representing oneself, either orally or in writing, as being able, whether real or imagined, to influence, facilitate or assist another person having some business, transaction, application, request or contract with the government in which the public official or employee has to intervene, in consideration of any present, gift or material or pecuniary advantage.
- Penalizes influence peddling by imprisonment of not more than six (6) years or fine of one hundred thousand pesos (P100,000.00) or both
