House Bill No. **4853**

Introduced by the Honorable Johnny T. Pimentel

AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A MULTI-SPECIES MARINE HATCHERY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF
BAROBO, PROVINCE OF SURIGAO DEL SUR, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Bureau of Fisheries
2 and Aquatic Resources of the Department of Agriculture, a multi-species marine hatchery in the
3 Municipality of Barobo, Province of Surigao del Sur.

5 SEC. 2. The BFAR-DA shall, within two (2) years after the construction of the multi-species
6 marine hatchery, transfer the management of the same to the local government unit concerned through
7 a memorandum of agreement. It shall implement a training and phasing-in -species marine hatchery.

9 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the
10 establishment of the multi-species marine hatchery in the Municipality of Barobo, Province of
11 Surigao del Sur, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General Appropriations Act. The
12 local government unit concerned shall set aside funds from any available local revenue in an amount
13 deemed appropriate for the operationalization of the hatchery.

15 SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days from the passage of this Act, the Secretary of Agriculture
16 shall issue the rules and regulations on the supervision, monitoring, transfer, or withdrawal by the
17 BFAR of the multi-species marine hatchery.

19 SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette*
20 or in a newspaper of general circulation.
