
Mr. Speaker:

House Bill No. 2924

(As approved by the Committee on October 18, 2016)

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY CRISTO REY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAPAS, PROVINCE OF TARLAC

Introduced by: Rep. Noel I. Villanueva

Committee Referral: Local Government

Committee Chairperson: Rep. Pedro B. Acharon, Jr.

OBJECTIVE:

- To establish Barangay Cristo Rey as a distinct and independent barangay and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Creates Barangay Cristo Rey in the Municipality of Capas, Province of Tarlac as an independent government entity
- Provides that the plebiscite conducted and supervised by the COMELEC pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 004- 2003 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Tarlac which ratified the creation of Barangay Cristo Rey as provided by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 13, 2003 shall serve as a substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement of the Local Government Code of 1991.
- Provides that the incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Cristo Rey shall continue to hold office until their successors have been duly elected and qualified
- Transfers all public infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act to the newly created barangays
- Entitles Barangay Cristo Rey to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of the Local Government Code, as amended, otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991

RELATED LAWS:

- Section 10 and 285 of Republic Act 7160, as amended otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991".
- Provincial Ordinance No. 004- 2003 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Tarlac.
