
Mr. Speaker:

**CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY CENTRAL SIGNAL VILLAGE IN
THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO MANILA**

Introduced by: Rep. Pia S. Cayetano

Committee Referral: Local Government

Committee Chairperson: Rep. Pedro B. Acharon, Jr.

OBJECTIVE:

- To establish Barangay Central Signal Village as a distinct and independent barangay and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Creates a barangay to be known as Barangay Central Signal Village, in the City of Taguig;
- Provides that the plebiscite conducted and supervised by the COMELEC pursuant to City Ordinance No. 60, Series of 2008 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation of Barangay Central Signal Village as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 28, 2008 shall serve as a substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
- Provides that the incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Central Signal Village shall continue to hold office until their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all existing public infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein to the newly created Barangay;
- Entitles Barangay Central Signal Village to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

RELATED LAW:

- Section 285 of Republic Act 7160, as amended otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991".
