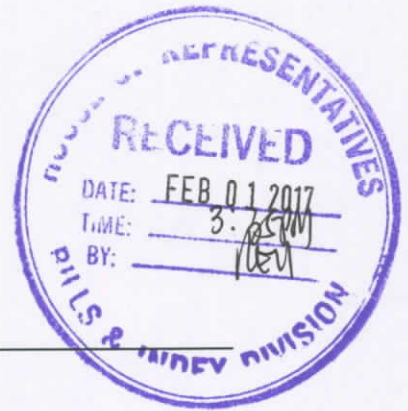


Mr. Speaker:

House Bill No. 3845

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY NEW LOWER BICUTAN IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO MANILA

Introduced by: Rep. Pia S. Cayetano

Committee Referral: Local Government

Committee Chairperson: Rep. Pedro B. Acharon, Jr.

OBJECTIVE:

- To establish Barangay New Lower Bicutan as a distinct and independent barangay and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Creates a barangay to be known as Barangay New Lower Bicutan, in the City of Taguig;
- Provides that the plebiscite conducted and supervised by the COMELEC pursuant to City Ordinance No. 69, Series of 2008 of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation of Barangay New Lower Bicutan as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 28, 2008 shall serve as a substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
- Provides that the incumbent barangay officials of Barangay New Lower Bicutan shall continue to hold office until their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all existing public infrastructure and facilities for public use therein to the newly created Barangay;
- Entitles Barangay New Lower Bicutan to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

- Section 285 of Republic Act 7160, as amended, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991".
