The Committee on Local Government to which was referred House Bill No. 284 introduced by Representative Maximo B. Dalog, entitled:



AN ACT
CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY PUDO IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF NATONIN, MOUNTAIN PROVINCE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives
of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Pudo*** – There is hereby created a barangay
2 to be known as Barangay Pudo in the Municipality of Natonin, Mountain Province.

3 **SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.*** – The plebiscite conducted and
4 supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial
5 Ordinance No. 1-S-91 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Mountain Province, which
6 ratified the creation of Barangay Pudo as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of
7 Canvassers on December 2, 1994 shall serve as substantial compliance with the
8 plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended otherwise
9 known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

10 **SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay officials of
11 Barangay Pudo, Municipality of Natonin, Mountain Province shall continue to hold
12 office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

1 **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.***— All public infrastructure and
2 facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby
3 transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new
4 barangay.

5 **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.***— Barangay Pudo shall be entitled to
6 Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No.
7 7160 as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

8 **SEC. 6. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
9 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY PUDO IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NATONIN, PROVINCE OF MOUNTAIN PROVINCE

Introduced by: Rep. Maximo B. Dalog

OBJECTIVE:

- To establish Barangay Pudo as a distinct and independent barangay and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Creates a barangay to be known as Barangay Pudo in the Municipality of Natonin, Mountain Province;
- Provides that the plebiscite conducted and supervised by the COMELEC pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 1-S-91 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Mountain Province, which ratified the creation of Barangay Pudo as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 2, 1994 shall serve as a substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
- Provides that the incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Pudo shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all existing public infrastructure and facilities for public use therein to the newly created Barangay;
- Entitles Barangay Pudo to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

RELATED LAWS:

- Sections 285 and 384 of Republic Act 7160, as amended otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991".
- Provincial Ordinance No. 1-S-91 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Mountain Province.
