(In Substitution of House Bill No. 2194)

AN ACT
RENAMING GOVERNOR'S DRIVE, TRAVERSING SORO-SORO BRIDGE
IN THE CITY OF BIÑAN, PROVINCE OF LAGUNA AND THE
MUNICIPALITY OF TERNATE, PROVINCE OF CAVITE, AS JUANITO R.
REMULLA, SR. ROAD

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. The Governor's Drive traversing Soro-Soro Bridge in the City of Biñan, Province of Laguna, the Municipalities of Carmona and General Mariano Alvarez, the Cities of Dasmariñas, General Trias, Trece Martires, and the Municipalities of Tanza, Naic and Ternate, Province of Cavite, is hereby renamed Juanito R. Remulla, Sr. Road.

SECTION 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
