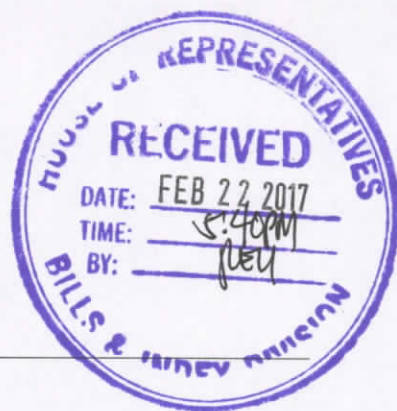

**Introduced by REPRESENTATIVES STRIKE B. REVILLA AND CELSO L.
LOBREGAT**

AN ACT
**RENAMING THE MOLINO BOULEVARD TRAVERSING BARANGAY
TALABA 4 AND BARANGAY SAN NICOLAS 3 IN THE CITY OF BACCOOR,
PROVINCE OF CAVITE AS BACCOOR BOULEVARD**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** The Molino Boulevard which traverses Barangays Talaba 4, Niog 3,
2 Ligas 2, Ligas 3, Bayanan, Mambog 4, Molino 2, Molino 3, San Nicolas1 and San
3 Nicolas 3, in the City of Bacoor, Province of Cavite, is hereby renamed as Bacoor
4 Boulevard.

7 **SECTION 2.** The Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) shall place
8 appropriate markers along Bacoor Boulevard and issue the necessary orders and circulars
9 to implement the provisions of this Act.

12 **SECTION 3.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
13 the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
