“AN ACT
CONVERTING THE TALISAY CITY COLLEGE IN THE CITY OF TALISAY, PROVINCE
OF CEBU INTO THE TALISAY CITY STATE COLLEGE, AMENDING FOR THE
PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10594, ENTITLED: “AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE
COLLEGE IN THE CITY OF TALISAY, PROVINCE OF CEBU TO BE KNOWN AS THE
TALISAY CITY STATE COLLEGE, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR”

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** Section 1 of Republic Act No. 10594 is hereby amended to read as follows:

2 “SECTION 1. Establishment. – There is hereby established a state college in the City of
3 Talisay, Province of Cebu BY CONVERTING THE TALISAY CITY COLLEGE INTO THE
4 TALISAY CITY STATE COLLEGE IN THE CITY OF TALISAY, PROVINCE OF CEBU,
5 hereinafter referred to as the College. ITS MAIN CAMPUS SHALL BE IN THE CITY OF
6 TALISAY, PROVINCE OF CEBU.”

7 **SECTION 2.** Section 24 of Republic Act No. 10594 is hereby amended to read as follows:

8 Section 24. Compliance with CHED Requirements. –

9 “xxx

10 “The following are the operational requirements for a college:

11 (a) [Level III accreditation or equivalent under CHED policies for at least four (4) of its
12 undergraduate programs, one (1) in liberal arts and one (1) in the sciences, and two (2)
13 of its graduate programs] THE APPROPRIATE OR EQUIVALENT
14 ACCREDITATION UNDER CHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES FOR
15 COLLEGES;

16 “xxx.

17 “The institution shall retain its status prior to the effectivity of this Act, unless in the
18 meantime it is able to comply with the requirements provided herein[, within a period not
19 exceeding January 1, 2016] ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2021.”

20 **SEC. 3.** The title of Republic Act No. 10594 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“AN ACT
CONVERTING THE TALISAY CITY COLLEGE IN THE CITY OF TALISAY, PROVINCE
OF CEBU INTO THE TALISAY CITY STATE COLLEGE, AMENDING FOR THE
PURPOSE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10594, ENTITLED: “AN ACT ESTABLISHING A STATE
COLLEGE IN THE CITY OF TALISAY, PROVINCE OF CEBU TO BE KNOWN AS THE
TALISAY CITY STATE COLLEGE, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR”

1 **SEC. 4.** All laws, executive orders, decrees, instructions, rules and regulations contrary to or
2 inconsistent with any provision of this Act are hereby amended, repealed or modified accordingly.

3 **SEC. 5.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette
4 or in a newspaper of general circulation.
