HOUSE BILL NO. **5214**
In substitution of House Bill No. 1637

Introduced by Representatives **GWENDOLYN F. GARCIA AND MARLYN L. PRIMICIAS-AGABAS**

AN ACT

1 **DECLARING JANUARY 6 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING**
2 **HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF TOLEDO, PROVINCE OF CEBU, IN**
3 **COMMEMORATION OF ITS CHARTER DAY ANNIVERSARY**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

4 SECTION 1. January 6 of every year is hereby declared a special non-
5 working holiday in the City of Toledo, Province of Cebu, in commemoration of its
6 Charter Day Anniversary. When the holiday falls on a Saturday or a Sunday, the
7 special non-working day shall be observed on the Monday that follows.

8 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
9 in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
