The Committee on Local Government to which was referred House Bill No. 310 introduced by Representative Allen Jesse C. Mangaong, entitled:



HOUSE BILL NO. 5220

AN ACT
SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF ILEB, NEW COLAYO VILLAGE, KINAMA AND NAMBARAN DAYA FROM BARANGAY NAMBARAN, CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY NAMBARAN EAST

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** *Creation of Barangay Nambaran East.* - The sitios of Ileb, New
2 Colayo Village, Kinama and Nambaran Daya are hereby separated from Barangay
3 Nambaran in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a separate and
4 independent barangay to be known as Barangay Nambaran East.

5 The territorial boundaries of Barangay Nambaran East shall be described as follows:

6 “Bounded on the East by the Municipality of Rizal; on the South by Barangay
7 Lacnog; on the West by Barangay Nambaran; and on the Northwest by Barangay Dilag.”

8 **SEC. 2.** *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – Pursuant to Section 10 of
9 Republic Act 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of
10 1991, the new Barangay Nambaran East shall exist upon the approval by a majority of the
11 votes cast by the qualified voters of Barangay Nambaran in a plebiscite to be conducted
12 and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in the area affected, within
13 ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act.

1 The amount necessary for the conduct of such plebiscite shall be borne by the
2 City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga.

3 **SEC. 3. *Barangay Officials.*** – The first set of officials of Barangay Nambaran
4 East shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor and shall hold office until such time
5 that their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

6 **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.***– All public infrastructure and
7 facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby
8 transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new
9 barangay.

10 **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.***- Barangay Nambaran East shall be
11 entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act
12 No. 7160 as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

13 **SEC. 6. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
14 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF ILEB, NEW COLAYO VILLAGE, KINAMA AND NAMBARAN DAYA FROM BARANGAY NAMBARAN, CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY NAMBARAN EAST

Introduced by: Rep. Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang

Committee Referral: Local Government

OBJECTIVE:

- To allow the tribal community to use their own Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) to chart their own course beneficial to the community;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Separates the Sitios of Ileb, New Colayo Village, Kinama and Nambaran Daya from Barangay Nambaran in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a separate and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Nambaran East;
- Describes the territorial boundaries of Barangay Nambaran East;
- Mandates the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) to conduct and supervise the plebiscite for approval by majority of the votes cast by qualified voters of Barangay Nambaran for the creation of Nambaran East within ninety (90) days from the date of the effectivity of the Act;
- Provides that the amount of expenses for the conduct of the plebiscite shall be borne by the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga;
- Provides that the first set of officials of Barangay Nambaran East shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor, and shall hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all public infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act to the newly created barangays; and
- Entitles Barangay Nambaran East to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160 as amended otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991.

RELATED LAW:

- Section 285 of Republic Act 7160, as amended, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991".
