The Committee on Local Government to which was referred House Bill No. 384 introduced by Representative Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang, entitled:



HOUSE BILL NO. 5221

Introduced by: Representative Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang

AN ACT
CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY IPIL IN THE
CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives
of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Ipil.*** - The Sitio of Ipil is hereby separated
2 from Barangay Bulanao in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a distinct
3 and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Ipil.

4 The territorial boundaries of Barangay Ipil are hereby described as follows:

5 “Bounded on the East by Barangay Nambaran and Barangay Lacnog; on the
6 South by Barangay Bulo; on the West by Barangay Bulanao Centro and Bulanao Norte;
7 on the Northwest by Barangay Magsaysay; and on the North by Barangay Dilag.”

8 **SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.*** - The plebiscite conducted and
9 supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in Barangay Bulanao
10 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-02 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the
11 Province of Kalinga, which ratified the creation of Barangay Ipil as proclaimed by the
12 Provincial Board of Canvassers on December 21, 2002 shall serve as substantial
13 compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160,
14 as amended otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

1 **SEC. 3. *Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Ipil
2 shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected
3 and qualified.

4 **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.***– All public infrastructures
5 and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are
6 hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new
7 barangay.

8 **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.***- Barangay Ipil shall be entitled to
9 Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No.
10 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

11 **SEC. 6. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
12 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

**CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY IPIL IN THE CITY OF TABUK,
PROVINCE OF KALINGA**

OBJECTIVE:

- To create Barangay Ipil as an independent government entity and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Separates the Sitio of Ipil from Barangay Bulanao in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Ipil;
- Describes the territorial boundaries of Barangay Ipil;
- Provides that the plebiscite conducted and supervised by the COMELEC pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-02 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Kalinga which ratified the creation of Barangay Ipil as proclaimed by the Provincial Board of Canvassers on December 21, 2002 shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
- Provides that the incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Ipil shall continue to hold office until their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all public infrastructure and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act to the newly created barangays; and
- Entitles Barangay Ipil to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160 as amended, otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991.

RELATED LAW:

- Section 285 of Republic Act 7160, as amended, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991".
