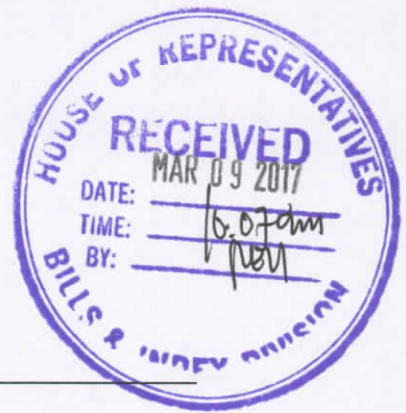

The Committee on Local Government to which was referred House Bill No. 309 introduced by Representative Allen Jesse C, Mangaoang entitled:


**“AN ACT

**AN ACT**  
**SEPARATING THE SITIOS OF GUINA-ANG, MADOPDOP, MALLANGO, LANLANA AND SAN PABLO FROM BARANGAY LACNOG, CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA, AND CONSTITUTING THEM INTO A SEPARATE AND INDEPENDENT BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY LACNOG WEST**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** *Creation of Barangay Lacnog West.* - The sitios of Guina-ang,  
2   Madopdop, Mallango, Lanlana, and San Pablo, are hereby separated from Barangay  
3   Lacnog in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a distinct and independent  
4   barangay to be known as Barangay Lacnog West.

5           The territorial boundaries of Barangay Lacnog West are described as follows:

6           “Bounded on the Southeast by Barangay Agbannawag; on the Southwest by  
7   Barangay Bulo; on the Northwest by Barangay Ipil; on the North by Barangay  
8   Nambaran; and on the East by Barangay Lacnog East.”

9           **SEC. 2.** *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – Pursuant to Section 10 of  
10   Republic Act 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of  
11   1991, the new Barangay Lacnog West shall exist upon the approval by a majority of the  
12   votes cast by the qualified voters of Barangay Lacnog in a plebiscite to be conducted and  
13   supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in the area affected, within  
14   ninety (90) days from the effectivity of this Act.

1           The amount necessary for the conduct of such plebiscite shall be borne by the  
2 City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga.

3           **SEC. 3. *Barangay Officials.*** – The first set of officials of Barangay Lacnog West  
4 shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor and shall hold office until such time that  
5 their successors have been duly elected and qualified.

6           **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.***– All public infrastructure and  
7 facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby  
8 transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new  
9 barangay.

10           **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.***– Barangay Lacnog West shall be  
11 entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act  
12 No. 7160 as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

13           **SEC. 6. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its  
14 publication in the Official Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.

**OBJECTIVE:**

- To create Barangay Lacnog West as an independent government entity and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

**KEY PROVISIONS:**

- Separates the Sitios of Guina-ang, Madopdop, Mallango, Lanlana, and San Pablo from Barangay Lacnog in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Lacnog West;
- Describes the territorial boundaries of Barangay Lacnog West;
- Mandates the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) to conduct and supervise the plebiscite for approval by majority of the votes cast by qualified voters of Barangay Lacnog for the creation of Barangay Lacnog West within ninety (90) days from the date of the effectivity of the Act;
- Provides that the amount of expenses for the conduct of the plebiscite shall be borne by the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga;
- Provides that the first set of officials of Barangay Lacnog West shall be appointed by the Provincial Governor, and shall hold office until such time that their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all public infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of the Act to the newly created barangays; and
- Entitles Barangay Lacnog West to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160 as amended, otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991
