HOUSE BILL NO. 5223

INTRODUCED BY: REPRESENTATIVE ALLEN JESSE C. MANGAOANG

AN ACT
CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY BULANAO NORTE IN THE CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives
of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 **SECTION 1.** *Creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte.* – The Sitio of Bulanao Norte
2 is separated from Barangay Bulanao and constituted into a distinct and independent
3 barangay to be known as Barangay Bulanao Norte in the City of Tabuk, Province of
4 Kalinga.

5 The territorial boundaries of Barangay Bulanao Norte are described as follows:
6 “Bounded on the East by Barangay Ipil; on the South and Southwest by Barangay
7 Bulanao Centro; and on the Northwest by Baarangay San Juan and Barangay Appas.”

8 **SEC. 2.** *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite conducted and
9 supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) pursuant to Provincial
10 Ordinance No. 2002-002 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Kalinga in
11 Barangay Bulanao, which ratified the creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte as proclaimed
12 by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers on December 21, 2002 shall serve as a substantial
13 compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act 7160, as
14 amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

1 **SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay officials of
2 Barangay Bulanao Norte shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors
3 have been duly elected and qualified.

4 **SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructure and Facilities.***– All public infrastructures and
5 facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of this Act are hereby
6 transferred without cost or compensation to and shall be administered by the new
7 barangay.

8 **SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.***- Barangay Bulanao Norte shall be
9 entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act
10 No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

11 **SEC. 6. *Effectivity.*** – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
12 publication the Official Gazette or in any newspaper of general circulation.

CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY BULANAO NORTE IN THE CITY OF TABUK, PROVINCE OF KALINGA

Introduced by: Rep. Allen Jesse C. Mangaoang

Committee Referral: Local Government

OBJECTIVE:

- To create Barangay Bulanao Norte as an independent government entity and entitle it to the appropriate Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share;

KEY PROVISIONS:

- Separates the Sitio of Bulanao Norte from Barangay Bulanao in the City of Tabuk, Province of Kalinga to constitute a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay Bulanao Norte;
- Describe the territorial boundaries of Barangay Bulanao Norte;
- Provides that the plebiscite conducted and supervised by the COMELEC pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2002-02 of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Kalinga which ratified the creation of Barangay Bulanao Norte as proclaimed by the Provincial Board of Canvassers on December 21, 2002 shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991;
- Provides that the incumbent barangay officials of Barangay Bulanao Norte shall continue to hold office until their successors have been duly elected and qualified;
- Transfers all public infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the approval of the Act to the newly created barangays; and
- Entitles Barangay Bulanao Norte to IRA shares pursuant to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160 as amended, otherwise known as The Local Government Code of 1991
