In substitution of House Bill No. 2747

Introduced by Representatives **MARLYN B. ALONTE, RAYMUND F. VILLAFUERTE, JR. AND MARLYN L. PRIMICIAS-AGABAS**

1 AN ACT

2 DECLARING FEBRUARY 3 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON-WORKING
3 HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF BIÑAN, PROVINCE OF LAGUNA, TO BE KNOWN AS
4 "BIÑAN LIBERATION DAY"

5 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
6 Congress assembled:

7 SECTION 1. February 3 of every year is hereby declared a special non-
8 working holiday in the City of Biñan, Province of Laguna, in commemoration
9 of the liberation of the town of Biñan, now the City of Biñan, from the Japanese
10 Imperial Forces, to be known as "Biñan Liberation Day".

11 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
12 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
