

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE PERLAS PILIPINAS WOMEN'S NATIONAL BASKETBALL TEAM FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE 2016 SOUTHEAST ASIAN BASKETBALL CHAMPIONSHIP FOR WOMEN HELD FROM SEPTEMBER 24 TO 26, 2016 IN MALACCA CITY, MALAYSIA

1 **WHEREAS**, the Southeast Asian Basketball Association (SEABA), a sub-
2 zone of the *Fédération Internationale de Basketball* (FIBA) Asia, regularly holds a
3 basketball tournament among national teams which serves as a qualifier for different
4 zone and subzone competitions such as FIBA Asia Championship for Women and
5 the Southeast Asian Games;

6 **WHEREAS**, SEABA held its ninth tournament in women's basketball from
7 September 24-26, 2016 that was participated in by seven (7) member participating
8 countries, namely: Indonesia, Laos, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and
9 Vietnam;

10 **WHEREAS**, with true grit, determination and team effort, Perlas Pilipinas, the
11 country's women's national basketball team, emerged victorious in all six (6) games
12 and won the gold medal after defeating the Malaysian team with a score of
13 seventy-seven (77) against seventy-three (73);

14 **WHEREAS**, this triumph is considered one of the Philippine's strongest
15 finishes in the tournament in the last six (6) years, having placed first in 2010,
16 second in 1995 and 1997 and third in 1992 and 2002;

1 **WHEREAS**, the victory of Perlas Pilipinas has elevated the Philippines to
2 second place (after Thailand) in the overall ranking, and is thus a defining moment
3 for the Philippine women's basketball;

4 **WHEREAS**, the members of Perlas Pilipinas, namely: Aracelie Abaca,
5 Analyn Almazan, Jack Danielle Animam, Janine Pontejos, Afril Bernardino, France
6 Mae Cabinbin, Raiza Rose Dy, Shelley Anne Gupilan, Allana May Lim, Cindy
7 Resultay, Camille Sambile, and Marizze Andrea Tongco, together with their head
8 coach Patrick Henry Aquino, assistant coaches Julie Amos and Paul Ramond Du,
9 team manager Wilbert Loa, and team official Dioceldo Sy, deserve recognition and
10 commendation for their indubitable spirit and resolute pursuit for excellence, and for
11 giving pride and honor to our country in the field of basketball: Now, therefore, be it

12 *Resolved by the House of Representatives*, To congratulate and commend
13 the Perlas Pilipinas Women's National Basketball Team for winning the gold medal
14 in the 2016 SEABA Championship for Women held from September 24 to 26, 2016
15 in Malacca City, Malaysia.

16 *Resolved, further*, That all members of Perlas Pilipinas team, including the
17 coaches and officials be furnished with a copy of this Resolution.
