
have considered the same and recommend that the attached House Bill No. 5374, entitled:

AN ACT
ESTABLISHING A FISH PORT IN THE CITY OF OROQUIETA, PROVINCE OF
MISAMIS OCCIDENTAL, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress
assembled:*

1 Section 1. There shall be established, under the supervision of the Department of
2 Agriculture through the Philippine Fisheries Development Authority (PFDA), a fish port in
3 the City of Oroquieta, in the Province of Misamis Occidental.
4

5 Sec. 2. Within two (2) years after the construction of the fish port, the PFDA, through
6 a memorandum of agreement, shall transfer its management to the local government unit
7 concerned. It shall implement a training and phasing-in program for local government
8 personnel on the management and operation of the fish port.
9

10 Sec. 3. The Secretary of Agriculture shall include in the Department's programs the
11 establishment of the fish port, the funding of which shall be included in the annual General
12 Appropriations Act. The local government unit concerned shall set aside funds from any
13 available local revenue in an amount deemed appropriate for the operationalization of the
14 fish port.
15

16 Sec. 4. Within sixty (60) days from the passage of this Act, the Secretary of
17 Agriculture shall issue the rules and regulations on the supervision and monitoring, and the
18 transfer or withdrawal by the PFDA, of the fish port.
19

20 Sec. 5. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official
21 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
