1 AN ACT

2 DECLARING APRIL 3 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NON WORKING HOLIDAY IN
3 THE PROVINCE OF ALBAY, INCLUDING THE CITIES THEREIN, IN
4 COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY, TO BE KNOWN AS
5 "ALBAY DAY"

6 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
7 Congress assembled:

8 SECTION 1. April 3 of every year is hereby declared a special non-
9 working holiday in the Province of Albay, including the cities therein, in
10 commemoration of its founding anniversary, to be known as "Albay Day".

11 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
12 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
