
"AN ACT

AN ACT

DECLARING APRIL 5 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN
THE PROVINCE OF PANGASINAN IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING
ANNIVERSARY, TO BE KNOWN AS THE "PANGASINAN DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. April 5 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking
2 holiday in the Province of Pangasinan in commemoration of its founding anniversary,
3 to be known as the "Pangasinan Day".

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
5 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
