AN ACT  
DECLARING FEBRUARY 3 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING  
HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF CABANATUAN, PROVINCE OF NUEVA ECIJA, IN  
COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in  
Congress assembled:

1           SECTION 1. February 3 of every year is hereby declared a special  
2 nonworking holiday in the City of Cabanatuan, Province of Nueva Ecija, in  
3 commemoration of its founding anniversary.

4           SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the  
5 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.

6           Approved,
