HOUSE BILL NO. **5688**
In substitution of House Bill No. 550

Introduced by Representatives **RAUL V. DEL MAR AND MARLYN L. PRIMICIAS-AGABAS**

AN ACT

DECLARING SEPTEMBER 21 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL WORKING HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF CEBU AND THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF CEBU, INCLUDING ITS HIGHLY URBANIZED AND COMPONENT CITIES, TO BE KNOWN AS "CEBU PRESS FREEDOM DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 SECTION 1. September 21 of every year is hereby declared a special
2 working holiday in the City of Cebu and the entire Province of Cebu, including its
3 highly urbanized and component cities, to be known as "Cebu Press Freedom Day".

4 SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
5 *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
