AN ACT

ESTABLISHING THE SARANGANI SPORTS TRAINING CENTER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF ALABEL, PROVINCE OF SARANGANI AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled.

1 **SECTION 1.** There shall be established in the Municipality of Alabel, Province of
2 Saranggani, a sports training center to be known as the "Sarangani Sports Training Center", which
3 shall be constituted as the primary sports development and training center for the Province of
4 Saranggani.

5 **SEC. 2.** The Provincial Government of Sarangani and the Municipal Government of Alabel,
6 in coordination with the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC), shall take the necessary steps to
7 upgrade, improve, and modernize existing facilities, equipment and personnel and integrate them
8 into the newly created sports training center.

9 The Provincial Government of Sarangani and the Municipal Government of Alabel, in
10 coordination with the PSC, shall create the necessary training programs, appropriate tournaments and
11 competitions, as well as the system by which the facilities shall be maintained and managed in order
12 to accomplish the objectives and purposes of this Act.

13 **SEC. 3.** The construction, establishment and operation of the Saranggani Sports Training
14 Center shall be funded by the Provincial Government of Saranggani and the Municipal Government
15 of Alabel, and such funds as may be granted by the PSC and by the Office of the President. In
16 addition, grants and endowments may be obtained from local or foreign sources intended for sports
17 development.

1 **SEC. 4.** The Chairman of the PSC shall immediately include in the Commission's program
2 the necessary funding requirements of the Sarangani Sports Training Center.

3 **SEC. 5.** The PSC, in coordination with the Provincial Government of Sarangani, the
4 Municipal Government of Alabel, and other concerned stakeholders, shall promulgate the necessary
5 rules and regulations for the implementation of this Act within ninety (90) days after its enactment
6 into law.

7 **SEC. 6.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette
8 or in a newspaper of general circulation.
