In substitution of House Bill No. 3718

Introduced by Representatives **GERALDINE B. ROMAN, JOSE ENRIQUE S. GARCIA III AND MARLYN L. PRIMICIAS-AGABAS**

AN ACT
DECLARING JANUARY 11 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE PROVINCE OF BATAAN IN COMMEMORATION OF ITS FOUNDING ANNIVERSARY, TO BE KNOWN AS "BATAAN FOUNDATION DAY"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. January 11 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday in the Province of Bataan in commemoration of its founding anniversary, to be known as "Bataan Foundation Day".

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
