A RESOLUTION

URGING THE DEPARTMENT OF TOURISM (DOT) TO INSTITUTIONALIZE AND PROMOTE

WHEREAS, the *Kalapati* Festival of Barangay Holy Spirit in Quezon City was launched in 2005, and has since been celebrated annually during the month of May;

WHEREAS, the Festival seeks to promote peace, justice, unity and national development and has made a strong and positive impact to the general public;

WHEREAS, the innate Filipino virtues and cultural heritage that shape Philippine society's consciousness are as much a part of national development as they are a part of the Filipino identity, and the *Kalapati* Festival inculcates in the participants such indigenous virtues;

WHEREAS, national awareness of native festivities that promote Filipino qualities and character toward which the attention of the international community is drawn bolsters national pride and honor and, therefore, need to be enhanced;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the House of Representatives to urge the Department of Tourism (DOT) to institutionalize and promote the *Kalapati* Festival of Barangay Holy Spirit in Quezon City.
