**AN ACT**  
**RE-NUMBERING THE CEBU 1<sup>ST</sup>, 2<sup>ND</sup> AND 4<sup>TH</sup> DISTRICT ENGINEERING OFFICES TO CONFORM AND CORRESPOND, RESPECTIVELY, WITH THE NUMBERING OF THE LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS IN THE PROVINCE OF CEBU**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1           **SECTION 1.** The current district engineering offices in the Province of Cebu shall  
2 be renumbered accordingly to conform and correspond, respectively, with the numbering of  
3 the three (3) legislative districts of the province. Each District Engineering Office shall serve  
4 the municipalities under the respective legislative district.  
5

6           **SEC. 2.** The Cebu First District Engineering Office, to be located within the First  
7 Legislative District of the Province of Cebu shall serve the Cities of Talisay, Carcar and Naga  
8 and Municipalities of Minglanilla, Sibonga and San Fernando. The Cebu Second District  
9 Engineering Office, to be located within the Second Legislative District of the Province of  
10 Cebu shall serve the Municipalities of Argao, Dalaguete, Alcoy, Boljoon, Oslob, Santander  
11 and Samboan. Finally, the Cebu Fourth District Engineering Office, to be located within the  
12 Fourth Legislative District, shall serve the City of Bogu and Municipalities of Bantayan, Daan  
13 Bantayan, Madridejos, Medellin, San Remigio, Santa Fe, Tabogon and Tabuelan

15           **SEC. 3.** The Secretary of Public Works and Highways shall issue the necessary rules  
16 and regulations to carry out the purpose of this Act.

18           **SEC. 4.** Republic Act 9043 and Republic Act 9218, constituting the Second and First  
19 Engineering District in the province of Cebu are hereby repealed accordingly  
20

21           **SEC. 5.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official  
22 Gazette or in a newspaper of general circulation.
