The Committee on Revision of Laws to which was referred House Bill No. 2325, introduced by Rep. Rene L. Relampagos, entitled:



**AN ACT**

**DECLARING JULY 4 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE ENTIRE PROVINCE OF BOHOL, TO BE KNOWN AS "FRANCISCO DAGOHOY DAY" IN HONOR OF FRANCISCO DAGOHOY, A NATIVE OF BOHOL AND LEADER OF THE LONGEST PHILIPPINE REVOLT ON RECORD THAT LASTED FOR 85 YEARS DURING THE SPANISH ERA**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1           SECTION 1. July 4 of every year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday  
2 in the entire Province of Bohol, to be known as "Francisco Dagohoy Day" in honor of  
3 Francisco Dagohoy, a native of Bohol and leader of the longest Philippine revolt on record  
4 that lasted for 85 years during the Spanish era.

5           SEC. 2. The Department of Education Regional Office shall plan and implement  
6 activities for the holiday and ensure that Francisco Dagohoy's legacy of courage and  
7 patriotism is given emphasis so as to encourage the youth to continue the good values and  
8 patriotism demonstrated by Francisco Dagohoy.

9           Moreover, to ensure meaningful observance of the holiday as herein declared, all  
10 heads of local government units and instrumentalities, including government-owned and  
11 controlled corporations, and employers in the private sector shall encourage and afford  
12 sufficient time and opportunities for their employees to engage and participate in any activity  
13 conducted within the premises of their respective offices or establishments to celebrate the  
14 "Francisco Dagohoy Day".

15           SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*  
16 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
