

**RESOLUTION**  
**CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING DINES DUMAAN FOR WINNING THE GOLD MEDAL IN THE PENCAK SILAT EVENT IN THE 29<sup>TH</sup> SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES (SEA GAMES) HELD IN KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA ON AUGUST 19 TO 30, 2017, AND HIS COACH AND THE OFFICIALS OF THE PHILSILAT SPORTS ASSOCIATION (PHILSILAT) FOR THEIR ABLE MENTORSHIP AND SUPPORT**

1           **WHEREAS**, the 29th Southeast Asian Games (SEA GAMES), a biennial multi-sport  
2 event was participated in by about four thousand six hundred forty-six (4,646) athletes  
3 from eleven (11) member countries including the Philippines, and was held in Kuala  
4 Lumpur, Malaysia from August 19 to 30, 2017;

5           **WHEREAS**, the twenty-two (22) year-old rookie Dines Dumaan won the gold  
6 medal in the Men's Tanding Putra Class A Forty-five (45) to Fifty (50) kilogram Division  
7 of the 29<sup>th</sup> SEA Games' Pencak Silat competition;

8           **WHEREAS**, Dumaan defeated his Indonesian opponent via a takedown with a  
9 score of 4 to 1;

10          **WHEREAS**, the Roxas City-native who was a newcomer in the SEA Games was  
11 overweight by four point four (4.4) pounds prior to the start of competition, but still  
12 overcame his opponent despite this handicap;

1           **WHEREAS**, Dumaan who was discovered in the national games, worked his way  
2 up the national team after impressively sparring with national team members;

3           **WHEREAS**, it is but fitting and proper to recognize the achievement of Dines  
4 Dumaan who brought pride and honor to the country by winning the first Pencak Silat  
5 gold medal in the SEA Games since 2005: Now, therefore, be it

6           *Resolved by the House of Representatives*, To congratulate and commend Dines  
7 Dumaan for winning the gold medal in the pencak silat event in the 29<sup>th</sup> Southeast Asian  
8 Games (SEA GAMES) held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on August 19 to 30, 2017, and his  
9 coach and the officials of the Philsilat Sports Association (PHILSILAT) for their able  
10 mentorship and support.

11           *Resolved, further*, That pencak silat athlete Dines Dumaan, his coach and the  
12 president of PHILSILAT be furnished with a copy of this Resolution.
