

**RESOLUTION**

**CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING JUDOKA KIYOMI WATANABE AND MARIYA TAKAHASHI FOR WINNING GOLD MEDALS IN THE WOMEN'S UNDER SIXTY-THREE (63) AND UNDER SEVENTY (70) KILOGRAM JUDO DIVISIONS, RESPECTIVELY, IN THE 29<sup>TH</sup> SOUTHEAST ASIAN GAMES (SEA GAMES) HELD IN KUALA LUMPUR, MALAYSIA ON AUGUST 19 TO 30, 2017, AND THEIR COACHES AND THE OFFICIALS OF THE PHILIPPINE JUDO FEDERATION (PJF) FOR THEIR ABLE MENTORSHIP AND SUPPORT**

1           **WHEREAS**, the 29th Southeast Asian Games(SEA Games), a biennial multi-sport  
2 event, which was participated in by aboutfour thousand six hundred forty-six (4,646) athletes  
3 from the eleven (11) member countries was held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia from August 19  
4 to 30, 2017;

5           **WHEREAS**, Filipino-Japanese Judoka Kiyomi Watanabe has once again emerged on  
6 top of the Women's under sixty-three (63) kilogram division, a feat she had done in the past  
7 two (2) SEA Games in 2013 and 2015;

8           **WHEREAS**, Watanabeearned the Philippines its 17<sup>th</sup> gold medal, after winning all her  
9 bouts via ippon, taking down her opponent in just thirty-six (36) seconds for her third straight  
10 SEA Games gold;

11           **WHEREAS**, sixteen (16) year-old Filipina-Japanese Mariya Takahashi delivered the  
12 Philippines its 21<sup>st</sup> gold medal for the Women's under seventy (70) kilogram judo division;

14           **WHEREAS**, in her SEA Games debut, Takahashi stunned the judo competition after  
15 winning by ippon victory in forty-eight (48) seconds over Surattana Thongsri, a four-time  
16 champion from Thailand;

1           **WHEREAS,** the Philippine judo team fulfilled its promise and gifted the country with  
2 two (2) gold medals in the women's division: Now, therefore, be it

3           *Resolved by the House of Representatives,* To congratulate and commend judoka  
4 Kiyomi Watanabe and Mariya Takahashi for winning gold medals in the Women's under sixty-  
5 three (63) and under seventy (70) kilogram judo divisions, respectively, in the 29<sup>th</sup> Southeast  
6 Asian Games (SEA GAMES) held in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on August 19 to 30, 2017, and  
7 their coaches and the officials of the Philippine Judo Federation (PJF) for their able mentorship  
8 and support.

10           *Resolved, further,* That athletes Kiyomi Watanabe and Mariya Takahashi, their  
11 respective coaches and the president of the PJF be furnished with a copy of this Resolution.
