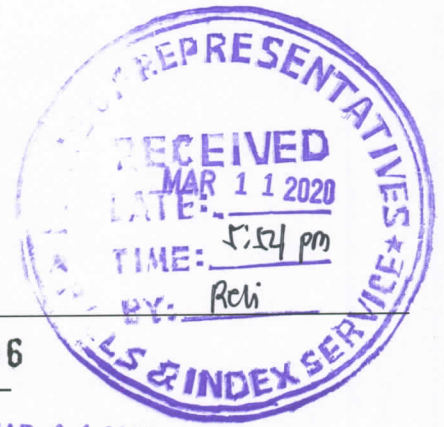



AN ACT

RENAMING THE COMPOSTELA VALLEY STATE COLLEGE IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF COMPOSTELA, PROVINCE OF COMPOSTELA VALLEY TO
THE DAVAO DE ORO STATE COLLEGE

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** The Compostela Valley State College in the Municipality of Compostela,
2 Province of Compostela Valley is hereby renamed as the Davao De Oro State College.

3
4 **SEC. 2.** The provisions of Republic Act No. 8292, otherwise known as the "Higher
5 Education Modernization Act of 1997", shall form an integral part of this Act and shall serve as
6 part of the Governing Charter of the College.

7
8 **SEC. 3.** All laws, executive orders, decrees, instructions, rules and regulations contrary
9 to or inconsistent with any provisions of this Act are amended, repealed or modified
10 accordingly.

12 **SEC. 4.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
13 *Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
