House Bill No. 7737

AN ACT DECLARING THE MUNICIPALITY OF LILIW IN THE PROVINCE OF LAGUNA, AS THE “TSINELAS CAPITAL OF THE PHILIPPINES”

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** The Municipality of Liliw in the Province of Laguna is hereby declared
2 the “Tsinelas Capital of the Philippines” in recognition of the economic and cultural
3 significance of its slippers industry which has existed for several decades and has been a
4 significant contributor to the economy of the Municipality of Liliw and the Province of
5 Laguna.

6 **SEC. 2.** Within sixty (60) days from the effectivity of this Act, the Department of
7 Tourism shall promulgate the necessary orders and circulars for the proper implementation of
8 this Act.

9 **SEC. 3.** All laws, rules, regulations, executive orders, proclamations, presidential
10 decrees and other issuances inconsistent with any of the provisions of this Act are hereby
11 deemed repealed or amended accordingly.

12 **SEC. 4.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the *Official*
13 *Gazette* or in a national newspaper of general circulation.
