At this point, Representative Defensor acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of the guest of Deputy Speaker Raneo “Ranie” E. Abu and Rep. Mario Vittorio “Marvey” A. Mariño.

SENATE TRANSMITTAL OF HOUSE BILLS

Thereupon, on motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body directed the Secretariat to immediately transmit to the Senate the recently-approved House Bills on Third Reading.

BUSINESS FOR THE DAY: COMMITTEE REPORT NO. 340 ON HOUSE BILL NO. 6112

On motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body considered on Second Reading House Bill No. 6112, as contained in Committee Report No. 340 and reported out by the Committees on Transportation.

Upon direction of the Chair, the Secretary General read the title of the Bill, to wit:

“AN ACT MANDATING THE INSTALLATION OF SAFETY MONITORING DEVICES IN PUBLIC UTILITY VEHICLES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.”

As copies of the Bill had been distributed to the Members, on motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body dispensed with the reading of the text of the measure without prejudice to its insertion into the Record of the House.

Subsequently, on motion of Representative Defensor, the Chair recognized Rep. Mariano Michael M. Velarde Jr., one of the main authors of the Bill, to sponsor the measure.

SPONSORSHIP SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE VELARDE

Speaking in Filipino, Representative Velarde stressed the importance of House Bill No. 6112 by discussing the effective use of closed-circuit television cameras (CCTVs) and other electronic gadgets such as global positioning system (GPS) tracking devices in deterring crimes and protecting people and properties not only in business establishments but also in public and private vehicles. He added that electronic data and videos are now used as court evidence to facilitate the prosecution of criminal complaints.

APPROVAL ON SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILL NO. 6112

Thereafter, on successive motions of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body terminated the period of sponsorship and debate; terminated the period of amendments in the absence of Committee and individual amendments; and approved House Bill No. 6112 on Second Reading through *viva voce* voting.

OMNIBUS APPROVAL ON SECOND READING OF CERTAIN HOUSE BILLS UNDER THE BUSINESS FOR THURSDAY AND FRIDAY

On an omnibus motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body considered on Second Reading the following House Bills calendared under the Business for Thursday and Friday, as contained in various Committee Reports and submitted by the Committee on Revision of Laws; dispensed with the reading of the texts of the measures without prejudice to their insertion into the Record of the House; adopted the Explanatory Notes as the sponsorship remarks on the measures; terminated the period of sponsorship and debate; terminated the period of amendments in the absence of Committee and individual amendments; and approved the same on Second Reading through *viva voce* voting:

1. House Bill No. 6160, as contained in Committee Report No. 347, declaring September 7 of every year a special nonworking holiday in Cavite City, Cavite, in commemoration of its founding anniversary;

2. House Bill No. 6161, as contained in Committee Report No. 348, declaring January 21 of every year a special nonworking holiday in Rodriguez, Rizal, in commemoration of the birth anniversary of Hon. Eulogio "Amang" Adona Rodriguez, Sr.; and
3. House Bill No. 6178, as contained in Committee Report No. 356, declaring January 11 of every year a special nonworking holiday in the Province of Bataan in commemoration of "Bataan Foundation Day."

REFERRAL OF HOUSE RESOLUTIONS ON INQUIRIES IN AID OF LEGISLATION

In accordance with the Rules governing inquiries in aid of legislation, on motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body referred the following House Resolutions to the appropriate Committees hereunder indicated:

1. House Resolution No. 1174, on the status of the planned integrated "new towns" as recommended in the Transport Development Plan of the National Economic and Development Authority – to the Committees on Housing and Urban Development, and Transportation;
2. House Resolution No. 1175, on the alleged recent corruption in the Court of Appeals – to the Committee on Good Government and Public Accountability;
3. House Resolution No. 1176, on the matter of inefficient collection of local taxes by the Bureau of Internal Revenue and to investigate the rampant corruption that has plagued the Bureau of Customs for

decades, both of which caused the tax gap to balloon to more than ₱400 billion in deficiency – to the Committee on Ways and Means;

4. House Resolution No. 1177, on the widespread prevalence of schistosomiasis in the country and prescribe legislative measures to prevent the disease from further spreading and promote its elimination – to the Committee on Health;
5. House Resolution No. 1179, on the death of triathlon athlete Eric Nadal Mediavillo in the 2017 Cobra Energy Drink Ironman 70.3 Philippines – to the Committee on Youth and Sports Development;
6. House Resolution No. 1182, on the current standards for approval of textbooks and/or learning materials or resources for both private and public schools, how such are formulated, reviewed, and published, and if necessary, to come up with an external oversight body to conduct the same – to the Committee on Basic Education and Culture;
7. House Resolution No. 1183, on the reported serious and substantial errors in the school textbooks and reading materials being used by students from K-12, inquiring into its overall impact on the quality of education of the children, whether in public or private schools and that measures, guidelines, and regulations be imposed for strict compliance and implementation – to the Committee on Basic Education and Culture;
8. House Resolution No. 1186, on the exorbitant fees or charges being collected by airline companies for the correction of typographical and clerical errors and re-issuance of airline tickets – to the Committee on Transportation; and
9. House Resolution No. 1187, on the dumping of 5,000 metric tons of garbage from South Korea in Cebu in February, 2017 – to the Committee on Ecology.

CONCURRENCE WITH SENATE AMENDMENTS TO CERTAIN HOUSE BILLS

With the consent of the Committee on Local Government and the authors of the following House Bills, on successive motions of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body concurred with the Senate amendments to:

1. House Bill No. 4925, dividing the one-barangay Municipality of Dumalneg, Ilocos Norte into three (3) distinct and independent barangays to be known as Barangays Kalaw, Cabaritan, and Quibel; and
2. House Bill No. 2924, creating Barangay Cristo Rey in Capas, Tarlac.

APPROVAL OF THE JOURNAL

Thereupon, on motion of Representative Defensor, there being no objection, the Body approved Journal No. 13, dated August 22, 2017.

creation of a province; dispensed with the reading of the text thereof without prejudice to its insertion into the Record of the House; as concurred by the sponsor of the Bill, Deputy Speaker Gwendolyn F. Garcia, adopted the Explanatory Note as the sponsorship remarks on the measure; terminated the period of sponsorship and debate; terminated the period of amendments in the absence of Committee and individual amendments; and approved the same on Second Reading through *viva voce* voting.
