RECONSIDERATION OF THE APPROVAL OF JOURNAL NO. 23

On successive motions of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Body reconsidered the approval of Journal No. 23, dated September 12, 2017; and the Chair recognized Rep. Raul V. Del Mar.

AMENDMENT OF REPRESENTATIVE DEL MAR

As proposed by Representative Del Mar, there being no objection, the Body approved on page 17, second paragraph, under the heading, “EXPLANATION OF REPRESENTATIVE DEL MAR,” to replace the phrase “should be decided upon during the period of amendments” with the phrase CAN ONLY BE DECIDED DURING THE NEXT CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS.

APPROVAL OF JOURNAL NO. 23, AS AMENDED

Thereupon, on motion of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Body approved Journal No. 23, dated September 12, 2017, as amended.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

Representative Gullas then acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of the guests of Reps. Kaka J. Bag-ao, Johnny Ty Pimentel, and Sabiniano S. Canama.

THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

With leave of the House, on motion of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and thereafter recognized Rep. Micaela S. Violago for her privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE VIOLAGO

Representative Violago decried the wrong portrayal of a Filipina nanny in Chile in the movie “Madre.” She asked for the Body’s support in collaboration with the appropriate government agency to minimize its negative impact on overseas Filipino workers (OFWs) in South America and other countries.

REFERRAL OF REPRESENTATIVE VIOLAGO'S PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Body referred Representative Violago’s privilege speech to the Committee on Rules.

Likewise, on motion of Representative Gullas, the Chair recognized Rep. Emmi A. De Jesus for her privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE DE JESUS

Speaking in Filipino, Representative De Jesus adverted to Malacañang’s confusing pronouncements about the celebration of September 21, 2017 not as a public holiday but as a national day of protest. Stressing that it was on said date that former President Ferdinand E. Marcos declared martial law

in the entire country, she stressed that such pronouncements were meant to promote a culture of disremembering and to weaken the capacity of citizens to join peaceful and democratic protests as well as condition their minds to think that military rule was legitimate.

Subsequently, Representative De Jesus stressed that September 21 will always be remembered as a dark hour in the nation’s history in spite of government efforts to remove it from the people’s memory. She said that extrajudicial killings, counter-insurgency, and the current declaration of martial law in Mindanao tended to divert the attention of the nation from the present condition of the country. She urged her colleagues to continue to fight for civilian supremacy and the rule of law; and to join her in nationwide activities to register their stand against any form of repression or abuse by the State.

REFERRAL OF REPRESENTATIVE DE JESUS' PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Body referred Representative De Jesus’ privilege speech to the Committee on Rules.

TERMINATION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

Subsequently, on motion of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Body terminated the Privilege Hour.

SUSPENSION OF SESSION

The session was suspended at 4:31 p.m., upon motion of Representative Gullas.

RESUMPTION OF SESSION

The session resumed at 4:32 p.m.

REFERRAL OF HOUSE RESOLUTIONS ON INQUIRIES IN AID OF LEGISLATION

In accordance with the Rules governing inquiries, in aid of legislation, on motion of Representative Gullas, there being no objection, the Body approved to refer the following House Resolutions to the appropriate Committees hereunder indicated:

1. House Resolution No. 1293, on the implementation of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10679, otherwise known as the Youth Entrepreneurship Act of 2015 – to the Committees on Basic Education and Culture, and Higher and Technical Education;

2. House Resolution No. 1294, on the development of Golden Rice or Vitamin A Rice – to the Committee on Agriculture and Food;
3. House Resolution No. 1297, on the murder of teenagers Kian Loyd delos Santos, Carl Angelo Arnaiz, and Reynaldo de Guzman – to the Committee on Human Rights;
4. House Resolution No. 1300, on the comprehensive review of existing laws, rules and regulations governing pre-need companies and health maintenance organizations (HMOs) in the Philippines – to the Committee on Banks and Financial Intermediaries; and
5. House Resolution No. 1306, on the compliance of CATS Motors Philippines with the provisions of R.A. No. 7394, or the Consumer Code of the Philippines – to the Committee on Trade and Industry.
