PRIVILEGE HOUR

It being a Monday, on motion of Representative Hofer, there being no objection, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and thereafter recognized Rep. Frederick W. Siao for his privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE SIAO

Representative Siao spoke on behalf of his constituents in Iligan City about the shipment of solid waste and garbage from South Korea to the Port of Tagoloan in Misamis Oriental where the Mindanao International Container Terminal is located.

He declared that as a consequence, the residents of Iligan City are rejecting the garbage containers that might enter into their city. He demanded certain courses of action including the arrest of, filing of cases against, and issuance of a hold departure order for the officers of the consignee and shipper concerned; the filing of a *note verbale* or diplomatic protest against the Republic of Korea by the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA); and a review by the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) of rules and procedures governing the importation and processing of solid waste.

He then thanked the Bureau of Customs personnel and officials for their diligent performance as regards the aforementioned shipment.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE ATIENZA

On motion of Representative Hofer, the Chair then recognized Rep. Jose L. Atienza Jr. who congratulated Representative Siao and expressed his support for the latter's desire to prevent the Philippines from becoming a garbage receptacle. He discussed with his colleague the kinds of garbage that were being brought into the country and the sectors responsible for the same including inefficient government agencies such as DENR and unscrupulous businessmen. The two Members agreed on the need to communicate with the DENR on the matter and push for pertinent legislation.

Representative Atienza then pointed out that garbage dumping places public health in danger and is prohibited by law. He stressed his support for any legal action that Representative Siao will take on the matter as he emphasized that the Philippines is a blessed paradise and not a garbage dump and the Members are duty-bound to protect it.
