THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

With the unanimous consent of the House, on motion of Rep. Bondoc, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REP. SARMIENTO (E.)

On motion of Rep. Bondoc, the Chair recognized Rep. Edgar Mary S. Sarmiento from the First District of Samar who defended the Members of the 17th Congress from their alleged incompetence to amend the Constitution. Speaking in Filipino, he said that they participated in the House-conducted executive course on legislation, were knowledgeable about the shortcomings of government, were exposed to the problems and concerns of their constituencies, and possessed integrity and heart and had the best interest of the people in mind. He explained that a new Constitution was necessary in view of the changing socio-economic indicators and that the same would still be subject to a plebiscite.

INTERPELLATION OF REP. ATIENZA

Rep. Jose L. Atienza Jr., whom the Chair recognized upon Rep. Bondoc's motion, asked whether the Members were elected to make laws but not to change the Constitution. Speaking in Filipino, he also asked whether they were prepared for the responsibility, tediousness, and hard work required should the Body be converted into a constituent assembly and whether they knew enough about federalization. He opined that nothing would beat the wisdom and academic knowledge of the delegates of a constitutional convention and emphasized that amending the Constitution was a complicated and time-consuming undertaking.

Rep. Sarmiento (E.) affirmed that he did not bring up the issue of amending the Constitution during the election campaign. However, he pointed out that Congress had the mandate to do so if need be; he was willing to work hard for constitutional amendments that will be beneficial to the people; and that initially, the House committees concerned would study all the aspects of federalism. He stated that he would like to defer the question about federalism considering that the model thereof is still being finalized.

Rep. Atienza stated that the Members are still lacking in knowledge and they are not yet ready to propose revisions to the Constitution. He said that the issue of whether or not Congress should convert it-

self into a constituent assembly or a constitutional commission is a continuing debate and reminded his colleagues to be very prudent on the matter as sometimes good intentions may lead to perdition. As he congratulated Rep. Sarmiento for highlighting the competence of the Members, he opined that their competence lie in legislative work and not as delegates to a constitutional convention.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

At this point, Rep. Sherwin N. Tugna acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of guests of Reps. Josephine Ramirez-Sato, Emmi A. De Jesus, and Arlene D. Brosas.

Thereafter, on motion of Rep. Tugna, the Chair recognized Rep. Vicente “Ching” S.E. Veloso for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REP. VELOSO

Rep. Veloso initially stated that the Members, especially Rep. Atienza, are qualified and capable of proposing revisions to the Constitution via constituent assembly. He then discussed with Rep. Sarmiento (E.) the danger of the possible involvement of big businesses in the process of selecting delegates to a constitutional convention, and the cost of holding a constitutional convention.

Rep. Veloso then pointed out that there are a lot of provisions in the Constitution that are not being implemented, among which are free medical services and free elementary, high school and college education which his constituents badly need as his district belongs to the poorest province in the country. He stated that he finds it “crazy” that the government would be wasting P7 billion for a constitutional convention when some districts are desperately in need of help.

Rep. Sarmiento stressed that the proposal to change the form of government to federalism aims to address the needs of the different provinces and balance the wealth and resources of the country.

As he also focused on the plight of poor senior citizens who are awaiting support from the national government, Rep. Veloso concluded that federalism will allow 1) equal representation of all the states, and 2) small provinces to be grouped with and subsidized by rich provinces.

For the record, he stressed that all the Members are qualified to become members of the proposed

constituent assembly, and while their performance remains to be tested, he expressed hope that they will not commit the mistakes of the members of the previous Constitutional Commission.

REFERRAL OF REP. SARMIENTO’S (E.) PRIVILEGE SPEECH

On motion of Rep. Tugna, there being no objection, the Body referred Rep. Sarmiento’s (E.) privilege speech and the interpellations thereon to the Committee on Rules.

RESUMPTION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

On motion of Rep. Tugna, there being no objection, the Body resumed the Privilege Hour.

Upon recognition by the Chair, on motion of Rep. Tugna, the Chair recognized Rep. Gus S. Tambunting from the Second District of Parañaque City to deliver his privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REP. TAMBUNTING

Rep. Tambunting cited the importance of the freedom of information by highlighting the following points: it is the very essence of democracy; it enables the people to participate in the decision-making process of government; it allows them to monitor and check any abuses of power or wrongdoing by leaders whom they have elected in office; and it helps the people prevent government officials from committing the wrongdoings at the expense and detriment of the people they vowed to serve. He pointed out that freedom of information is so important that it has been enshrined in the 1973 and 1987 Constitutions both of which recognize the right of access of the people to matters of public concern and guarantee the right of the people to access official records, documents, papers pertaining to official acts, transactions, decisions and research data used as basis for policy development. Although there were laws passed to make available information needed by the public or the courts, he disclosed that these laws had not been effective in curbing the commission of anomalous transactions in government. It is for this reason, he said, that he had filed the Freedom of Information Bill in the 16th Congress but he lamented that the Members failed to pass it on time maybe for more urgent and pressing reasons.

He then informed the Body that on June 30, 2016, he had reintroduced House Bill No. 126 or the Freedom of Information Bill which would help President Rodrigo Roa Duterte achieve his goal of alleviating if not eradicating poverty in the country by attracting international and local investments in the country. He expressed hope that the Members, through further debates, deliberations and requisite public hearings, would come out with a law that includes all essential elements of a genuine Freedom of Information Law. Considering that the President announced during his SONA that he had signed and issued an executive order requiring public disclosure

of documents related to government transactions, assets, liabilities and net worth of government officials, and other documents to media and the public, subject to certain conditions such as national security and others, he said that the President needs the help and support of the Legislative and the Judicial branches of government. It is in this light that he would seek the support of the Members in passing House Bill No. 126 the soonest possible time.
