"AN ACT GRANTING PHILIPPINE CITIZENSHIP TO MR. PHILLIP LEACH."

Representative Garcia stated that the parliamentary status was that the measure was in the period of sponsorship and debate; and on his motion, the Chair recognized Rep. Reynaldo V. Umali, Chairperson of the Committee on Justice, to sponsor the measure, and Rep. Edcel C. Lagman to interpellate thereon.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE LAGMAN

Stating that he was not opposed to the Bill, Representative Lagman asked about the constitutional basis of granting citizenship to a foreigner; the House leadership's policies thereon; and the 10-year residency requirement for citizenship applicants as he held that Mr. Leach had not yet satisfied the same.

Representative Umali referred him to subparagraph 4 of Section 1, Article IV of the Constitution, Commonwealth Act (C.A.) No. 473, and Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9139 and explained the legislative process of granting citizenship as provided for in the amended Provisional Rules of the House. He

also stressed that the policy of the House is to grant citizenship to a foreigner, subject to the individual and collective wisdom of its Members.

After Representative Umali enumerated Mr. Leach's contributions to agriculture, tourism, and philanthropy in the country that will enable him to be covered by the five-year minimum residency requirement under C.A. No. 473, Representative Lagman explained that his questions were anchored on his desire for the House to establish policies for granting citizenship not on a case-to-case basis but based on (1) the minimum requirements of C.A. No. 473 or (2) the specific attributes of the citizenship applicant. He however stated that when he was the Chairperson of the Committee on Justice, he did not recommend the approval of citizenship bills as the policy then was to let the foreigner undergo the regular judicial or administrative process of naturalization.

Representative Umali said that the Subcommittee on Naturalization will discuss Representative Lagman's inputs. To his final remark, however, that Mr. Leach's application was one of a kind, Representative Lagman pointed out that several American basketball players had already been granted Filipino citizenship.

Thereafter, on motion of Representative Garcia (J.E.), the Chair recognized Rep. Raul A. Daza for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE DAZA

To the queries of Representative Daza, Representative Umali affirmed that House Bill No. 7120, if it becomes a law, was a direct exercise of the legislative power of Congress and not of any existing law or statute. He also said that the Subcommittee on Naturalization had verified the information given by Mr. Leach about establishing a new revolutionary technology in the coconut industry which is now being used by the Department of Agriculture.

Thereupon, Representative Daza expressed support for House Bill No. 7120.

TERMINATION OF THE PERIOD OF SPONSORSHIP AND DEBATE

There being no other Member who wished to interpellate the Sponsor, on motion of Representative Garcia (J.E.), there being no objection, the Body terminated the period of sponsorship and debate, and thereafter proceeded to the period of amendments.

PERIOD OF AMENDMENTS

There being no Committee and individual amendments, on motion of Representative Garcia (J.E.), there being no objection, the Body terminated the period of amendments,

APPROVAL ON SECOND READING OF HOUSE BILL NO. 7120

On motion of Representative Garcia (J.E.), there being no objection, the Body approved on Second Reading House Bill No. 7120 through *viva voce* voting.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

At this point, Representative Garcia (J.E.) acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of guests of Rep. Ramon "Rav" V.A. Rocamora.

OMNIBUS APPROVAL ON SECOND READING OF CERTAIN HOUSE BILLS UNDER THE BUSINESS FOR THURSDAY AND FRIDAY

On an omnibus motion of Representative Garcia (J.E.), there being no objection, the Body considered on Second Reading the following House Bills calendared under the Business for Thursday and Friday, as contained in various Committee Reports and submitted by the Committees concerned; dispensed with the reading of the texts thereof without prejudice to their insertion into the Record of the House; adopted the Explanatory Notes as the sponsorship remarks on the measures; terminated the period of sponsorship and debate; terminated the period of amendments in the absence of Committee and individual amendments; and approved the same on Second Reading through *viva voce* voting:

- 1. House Bill No. 7016, as contained in Committee Report No. 579 and submitted by the Committee on Local Government, creating the position of Assistant City Administrator, emphasizing the prohibition on illegal gambling, and establishing the City Registry of Deeds Office, amending for the purpose Sections 7, 10, 36, 51 and 52 of R.A. No. 8983 otherwise known as the Charter of the City of Bayawan;
- House Bill No. 7166, as contained in Committee Report No. 602 and submitted by the Committees on Higher and Technical Education, and Appropriations, converting the Kabasalan Institute of Technology in

Kabasalan, Zamboanga Sibugay, into the Zamboanga Sibugay Polytechnic Institute (ZSPI);

- 3. House Bill No. 7175, as contained in Committee Report No. 603 and submitted by the Committees on Basic Education and Culture, and Appropriations, separating the Igbaras National High School Alameda Extension in Alameda, Igbaras, Iloilo from the Igbaras National High School, converting it into an independent national high school to be known as Alameda National High School; and
- 4. House Bill No. 7177, as contained in Committee Report No. 605 and submitted by the Committees on Basic Education and Culture, and Appropriations, separating the Polo National High School Malanday Annex in Malanday, Valenzuela City from the Polo National High School, converting it into an independent national high school to be known as Malanday National High School.
