On motion of Rep. Hofer, the Chair suspended the session at 4:09 p.m.

THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

It being a Monday, on motion of Rep. Alexandria P. Gonzales, there being no objection, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and thereafter recognized Rep. Rosanna "Ria" Vergara for her privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REP. VERGARA

Rep. Vergara said that while the internet had become a daily necessity and a tool of convenience and connectivity, it was also being used for pedophilia and cybersex as well as internet gaming and gambling throughout the world. Focusing on the Philippines, she spoke about the new and popular internet game called Counter Strike: Global Offensive (CS:GO) that had espoused betting, trading, purchasing, and buying of game accessories using real money, provided a community platform for the same, and continued to scam millions of players especially children despite the filing of a federal law suit in the United States against its developers. She pointed out that cards used to play this game were purchased from computer retail stores and even from Globe Telecommunications. She warned that the effect of online gambling was similar to that of any other type of substance abuse addiction and led to depression, isolation, and school problems, and financial losses; and mentioned a new social media game called Blue Whale that even encouraged suicide among teenagers in Russia.

Subsequently, Rep. Vergara stressed the need to protect children and their families from the dangers of internet gaming. She suggested that the Commission on Higher Education conduct seminars on internet gaming especially in primary and secondary schools; and said that she will file a Bill requiring the Department of Education to include in the school curriculum a subject on the internet and social media. She added that Congress should create an office under the newlycreated Department of Information and Communications Technology that will review, classify, regulate or even block dangerous internet games. She stressed that the 17th Congress should work for the socio-economic, educational, and spiritual well-being especially of the Filipino youth.
