ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF GUESTS

At this point, Rep. Ria Christina G. Fariñas acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of the guests of Reps. Jose “Bong” J. Teves Jr., Ferdinand R. Gaite, and Lolita T. Javier.

CHANGE OF REFERRAL OF HOUSE BILL NO. 6

On subsequent motion of Representative Fariñas (R.C.), there being no objection, the Body changed the referral of House Bill No. 6 from the Committee on Basic Education and Culture to the Committee on Appropriations.

THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

With the permission of the Speaker and the unanimous consent of the Members, on motion of Representative Fariñas (R.C.), the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and subsequently recognized Rep. Ferdinand R. Gaite for his privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE GAITE

On behalf of the labor sector, Representative Gaite denounced the veto by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte of the Security of Tenure (SOT) Bill despite

his election promise to end labor contractualization. He presented facts and figures on the worsening rate of various types of contractualization and on layoffs instead of regularization; cited labor law violations and the violent dispersal of workers' strikes in such companies as the Pepmaco Manufacturing Corporation; and rued the lack of support from regional offices of the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) for reports on contractualization. Calling for an end to contractualization, he stressed that Congress must prioritize laws on security of tenure and President Duterte should listen more to labor rather than to foreign and local capitalists.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE SALO

On motion of Representative Fariñas (R.C.), the Chair recognized Rep. Ron P. Salo who asserted that the unemployment rate under the Duterte administration was lower compared to that in past administrations. He agreed with Representative Gaité on the need to provide more employment, protect the interest of the labor sector, plug the loopholes of existing labor laws, and revisit the DOLE's definition of employment. He opined that the DOLE should be given more resources and personnel to enable it to protect the rights of workers; and that the Members must balance the need to protect the security of tenure of workers against the layoff of more workers as a result of the same.

Thereafter, on motion of Representative Fariñas, the Chair recognized Rep. Jose L. Atienza Jr. for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF REPRESENTATIVE ATIENZA

Representatives Atienza and Gaité focused their discussion on the effects on labor force of the presidential veto of the SOT Bill, with the former pointing out that it would be unfair and socially unjust for contractual workers to lose their jobs in case the said law was passed. He opined that the measure will not solve the unemployment problem and might even increase the country's unemployment rate because no business could survive in case contractualization is made illegal. Thus, by vetoing the SOT Bill, he claimed that the president has saved the country from serious economic dislocation.

For his part, Representative Gaité stressed that social justice dictates that in a growing economy, the worker should be entitled to a decent living wage, humane work conditions, and security of tenure. He noted that management has used and neglected the labor force for a long time; hence, it is about time that the workers' rights should be protected.

After the two Members debated on the applicability of labor laws in the public and private sectors, Representative Atienza said he was amenable to the presidential veto of the SOT Bill and the president's decision for Congress to review the measure which, he opined, should contain provisions that will ensure benefits to the economy as well as to the labor force. This, as he manifested that he is not a Duterte fan but is a defender of the common good and the public welfare.

Representative Atienza then thanked Representative Gaité for his conviction, reminded his colleagues to legislate laws based on the needs of all sectors, and reasoned out that the SOT Bill was a simplistic slogan that cannot solve the problem of ordinary Filipino workers.

On motion of Representative Fariñas (R.C.), the Chair next recognized Deputy Speaker Rodante D. Marcoleta for his interpellation.

INTERPELLATION OF DEPUTY SPEAKER MARCOLETA

Initially, Deputy Speaker Marcoleta contended that President Duterte vetoed the SOT Bill because he had to delicately and sensitively balance the interests of the capitalists and the working class, and that the chief executive should be given enough time and the chance to carry out his campaign promise to end contractualization while he is still in office.

Deputy Speaker Marcoleta and Representative Gaité also exchanged views on the forthcoming era of rapid technology or the so-called "Fourth Industrial Revolution" and its possible effects on labor market and relations.

EXTENSION OF THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

On motion of Representative Fariñas (R.C.), there being no objection, the Body approved to extend the Privilege Hour for another 60 minutes.

**INTERPELLATION OF
REPRESENTATIVE VELOSO**

Recognized by the Chair upon motion of Rep. Fariñas (R.C.), Rep. Vicente S.E. Veloso initially clarified with Representative Gaité that it was the Senate version of the SOT Bill which was vetoed by the President. They then discussed the provisions of the Bill that the latter was not amenable to, the concept of fixed-term employment, and the forms of labor contractualization.

Representative Veloso agreed with the decision of the President to veto the Senate version of the SOT Bill and pointed out that despite the veto, endo or fixed-term employment and labor-only contracting are still prohibited under the Labor Code. He believed that as the father of the nation, President Duterte was merely protecting not only the right not only of the workers to equal protection of the law but the employers' right to the same as well when he still allowed some forms of contractualization. He agreed that Congress should review the SOT Bill because the Senate version thereof was not consistent with the House version which was painstakingly deliberated and drafted by the Committee on Labor of which he was the vice chairperson in the last Congress.

**INTERPELLATION OF
REPRESENTATIVE GO (M.)**

Upon recognition by the Chair, Rep. Mark O. Go discussed with Representative Gaité the latter's objection to all forms of contractualization, and his apprehension about President Duterte's inconsistent stance on ending contractualization.

The two Members discussed further the pros and cons of the various forms of contractualization, and the reasons behind the president's veto of the SOT Bill. Representative Go said he was one of the lawmakers who proposed to remove labor-only and job-only contracting schemes, and to just call them "outsourcing" so as to provide protection for both the employers and the employees.

They then exchanged views on the effects of zero contractualization as strongly proposed by Representative Gaité but opposed by Representative Go. The latter stressed that the issue is not only for zero contractualization to be pushed but to encourage the companies to improve their businesses so that they can earn big profit and

help their workers in return. He stressed the need to balance the interests of workers and capitalists.

**INTERPELLATION OF
REPRESENTATIVE SUNTAY**

Next recognized by the Chair upon motion of Representative Fariñas (R.C.), Rep. Jesus "Bong" C. Suntay said he is one with Representative Gaité in his desire to provide more benefits for Filipino workers. However, he stressed the importance of having a healthy and balanced economy by taking into consideration the welfare of workers and that of business establishments as well.

At this point, Deputy Speaker Puno relinquished the Chair to Deputy Speaker Dan S. Fernandez.

The two Members also discussed the concept of seasonal workers scheme and how this is being abused by some employers by hiring them as contractual workers.

Deputy Speaker Fernandez thereafter relinquished the Chair to Deputy Speaker Puno.

Representative Suntay argued that regularization of all workers might not be efficient and cost-effective, particularly for seasonal industries which only hire more workers during peak seasons. On the other hand, while Representative Gaité agreed to the protection of industries, he believed that the concept of seasonal work had been abused by industries; hence, the need for employment protection.

**REFERRAL OF PRIVILEGE SPEECH
OF REPRESENTATIVE GAITE**

On motion of Representative Bondoc, there being no objection, the Body referred Representative Gaité's privilege speech and interpellations thereon to the Committee on Rules.

**PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF
REPRESENTATIVE ZUBIRI**

Thereafter, on motion of Representative Bondoc, the Chair recognized Rep. Manuel F. Zubiri who congratulated the Members of the 17th Congress for achieving an all-time high net satisfaction rating from the SWS survey in June 2019. Subsequently, he expressed his gratitude to his fellow House Members and to the officials and employees of the House of Representatives for their

valuable work. With this achievement, he thanked and commended in advance the House Members of the 18th Congress for their future endeavors and achievements and urged them to continue improving their work for the country's progress.

REFERRAL OF PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE ZUBIRI

On motion of Rep. Marlyn "Len" B. Alonte, there being no objection, the Body referred Representative Zubiri's privilege speech to the Committee on Rules for its appropriate action.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE ALMARIO

On motion of Representative Alonte, there being no objection, the Chair recognized Rep. Joel Mayo Z. Almario who initially congratulated Speaker Alan Peter "Compañero" S. Cayetano for his new role as leader of the House of Representatives.

Thereafter, he commended the government's efforts to rehabilitate Boracay Island. He then adverted to President Duterte's statements in his State of the Nation Address (SONA) that local government units must enforce environmental laws and he will dismantle structures that clog and poison the country's waters.

Representative Almario subsequently asked that the government address the unmitigated and unregulated establishment of informal dwellings and communities beside bodies of water. He explained that unlike tourist establishments, informal dwellers do not comply with environmental permits and laws, pay taxes for conservation programs, and have proper waste disposal and sewerage systems--thus resulting in water pollution and biodiversity destruction.

In closing, he reiterated the president's call in his SONA, for the Department of the Interior and Local Government and Department of Environment and Natural Resources to clean up the country's shoreline.

REFERRAL OF PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE ALMARIO

On motion of Representative Bondoc, there being no objection, the Body referred

Representative Almario's privilege speech to the Committee on Rules.


