REMARKS OF REPRESENTATIVE REMULLA

At this point, Representative Macapagal Arroyo acknowledged the presence in the Session Hall of the guests of Reps. Vicente “Ching” S.E. Veloso III and Rufus B. Rodriguez.

THE PRIVILEGE HOUR

With the permission of the Speaker and the unanimous consent of the Members, on motion of Representative Macapagal Arroyo, there being no objection, the Chair declared a Privilege Hour and subsequently recognized Rep. Jose L. Atienza Jr. for his privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE ATIENZA

In his speech, Representative Atienza lauded the landmark decision of the Supreme Court (SC) in penalizing the two water concessionaires, the Maynilad Water Services, Inc. and Manila Water Co., Inc., as well as the Metropolitan Waterworks and Sewerage System (MWSS), for violation of the Clean Water Act. He stressed that said SC ruling affirmed the decision of the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) which had imposed fines on the two concessionaires for violating their contracts by not providing wastewater treatment facilities as mandated by law, and the MWSS for not enforcing and implementing the law.

Representative Atienza congratulated the SC for voting unanimously on the issue; enjoined his colleagues to support the DENR in its effort to enforce the law and protect the people against the abuses of big corporations; and stated that the SC decision has proven that the law always prevails.

REFERRAL OF PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE ATIENZA

On motion of Representative Macapagal Arroyo, there being no objection, the Body referred Representative Atienza's privilege speech to the Committee on Rules for its appropriate action.

Thereafter, on motion of Representative Macapagal Arroyo, the Chair recognized Rep. Sarah Jane I. Elago for her privilege speech.

PRIVILEGE SPEECH OF REPRESENTATIVE ELAGO

At the outset, Representative Elago congratulated her colleagues for joining the celebration all around the world of the International Youth Day. She then cited the activities being staged by several youth organizations in celebration of the said event and the *Buwan ng Wikang Pambansa*. She urged the

government to carry out its mandate to preserve and promote the Filipino language as the national language as well as the other native languages in the country.

After describing the implications of a memorandum order of the Commission of Higher Education which deferred the teaching of Filipino and *Panitikan* subjects in college, Representative Elago called on her colleagues and all government agencies concerned to (1) ensure the mandatory teaching of Filipino and *Panitikan* subjects in college; (2) restore the teaching of Philippine history in high school; (3) advance a nationalist education; and (4) promote an educational system that upholds the common good and the public welfare as its primary concern.
