

For the first half of 2018 alone, Siargao Island received a total of 163,245 tourists. This number is expected to significantly increase this year since the island was declared as the Best Island in Asia by Conde Nast 2018. Attention has not been focused, however, only on the island's tourist attractions but also on the dire state of its district hospital. Thus, in the news are not only its pristine beaches and crystal clear waters but also accidents and emergency cases which cannot be responded to adequately by the hospital. It is therefore, imperative that the condition of the district hospital be improved in order to address the growing need for sufficient medical care, not only of tourists, but residents as well.

The Siargao District Hospital, located in the Municipality of Dapa, in Surigao del Norte, was meant to be a Level I General Hospital with a bed capacity of fifty (50). Unfortunately, however, due to insufficient funds, the hospital has been downgraded to an infirmary with an existing bed capacity of only thirty (30). Apart from the need for equipment and medicines, the hospital's biggest concern is the lack of personnel and manpower. It has only three (3) regular doctors, including its Chief of Hospital, only one (1) pharmacist, and less than twenty (20) nurses. It also needs IT personnel, a supply officer, and janitors.

1 SEC. 3. The Secretary of Health shall immediately include in the
2 Department's programs the implementation of this Act, the funding of

4 SEC. 4. Within sixty (60) days after the approval of this Act, the
5 DOH shall promulgate the necessary rules and regulations for the effective
6 implementation of this Act.
7 SEC. 5. All laws, decrees, executive orders and other presidential
8 issuances which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed,
9 amended or modified accordingly.
10 SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
11 publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
12 circulation.
